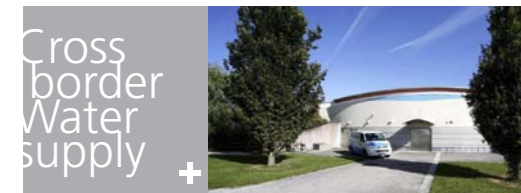


## BEST PRACTISE IN INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT by a wide range of financing and PPP models

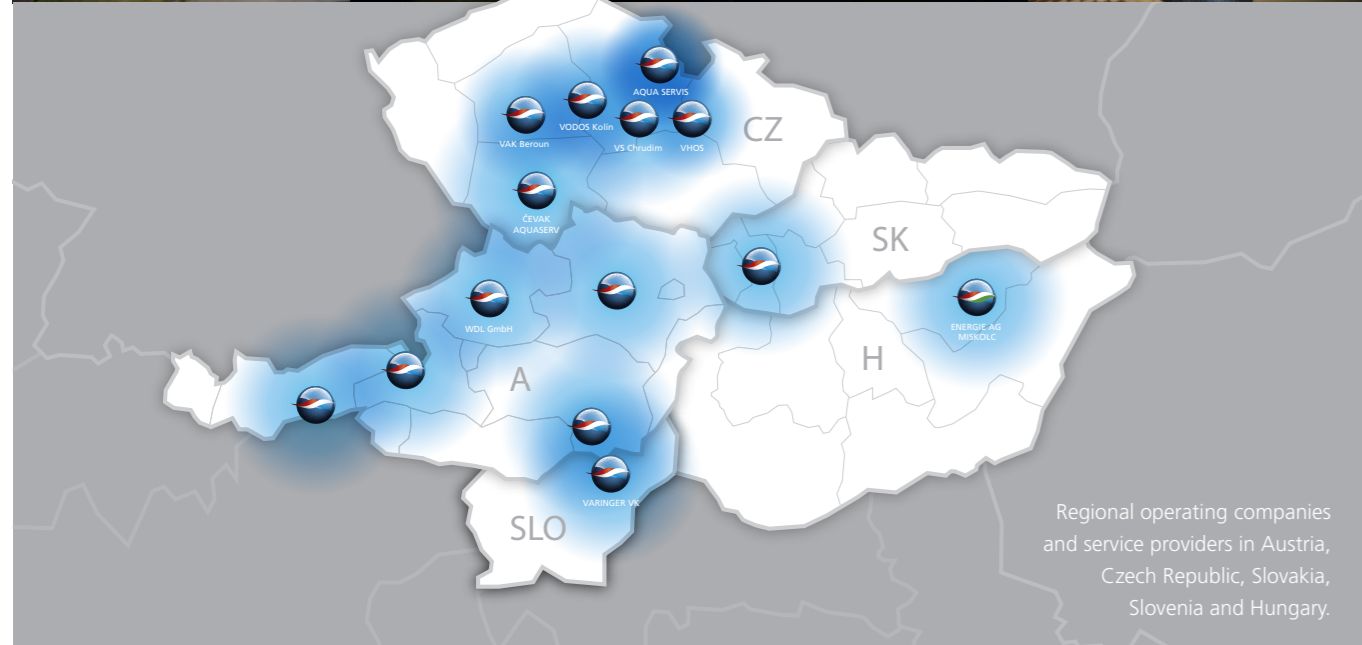
